After a good morning's graft we were treated to a cooked breakfast in the community hall. Many thanks to those that made that possible.





**NOTES FROM THE MEETING OF THE PARISH COUNCIL HELD
IN THE COMMUNITY HALL ON THURSDAY 10th OCTOBER at 7.30pm**

Present at the meeting were 8 Parish Councillors, District Councillor Dave Busby and 4 members of the public. Apologies for absence were received from Ben Cox, Chris Leney and Roy Carter.

New member: Les Cole had put himself forward to fill the current vacancy and it was a unanimous decision to co-opt him on to the Parish Council. Les is already Leader of the Community Speedwatch Team and has a keen interest in local planning issues, and I am confident that he will be an asset to the P.C.

District Council Report: Dave Busby reported that the free swimming sessions for young people at the Hadleigh Pool over the summer holidays had been a success and it is hoped that this will be repeated in the future. Cllr Busby also said that work had started on building the new swimming pool at a cost of £2.4 million, and it should be open in late Spring of next year.

County Council Report: Unfortunately no show means no report.... them's the rules.


