**NOTES FROM THE MEETING OF THE PARISH COUNCIL HELD AT THE  
COMMUNITY HALL ON THURSDAY 11th DECEMBER, 7.30 pm**

Present at the meeting were 9 Parish Councillors, District Councillors Nick Ridley and Peter Jones and 4 members of the public.

**Neighbourhood Plan:** Following on from recent advice from Planning Minister Brandon Lewis, the Parish Council have decided to form a 5 person Steering Group to assess the viability of such a scheme. Our intention is to gather information from informed parties before presenting guidance to Parish Council at a later date.

**County Council Report:** Although again absent from the meeting, Councillor David Busby had sent details of the Suffolk Better Broadband Programme. As previously reported, Hintlesham will be part of the Phase 5 programme. For more detail please click onto the following link.

**District Council Report:** Cllr Nick Ridley advised that the application for a giant wind turbine near Belstead would finally go before Babergh's Planning Committee on Wednesday 17th December. The Officer Advice will be to reject the application on the following grounds. Firstly, that according to the Ministry of Defence, the size of the turbine would present a danger to low flying aircraft from RAF Wattisham, and secondly that the economic benefit did not outweigh the damage to the local landscape. Cllr Ridley also mentioned that the developers of a proposed housing development adjacent to the Holiday Inn, Copdock, have plans to hold a public consultation in the near future.

**Risk Management Working Party:** held their latest meeting on Tuesday 9th December. Cllr Ian Bryce reported that the surfaces to both Playing Areas needed remedial work. As the Parish Council had around £19k of Section 106 Funds available, it was agreed that Cllrs Bryce and Whyman would liaise with Babergh DC to see if funds could be released to pay for this work.

**Community Infrastructure Levy:** The Chairman and Parish Clerk had recently attended an awareness meeting regarding this new scheme. As funding from Central Government to District Councils is reduced, the intention is that District Councils will be able to raise funds through increased local housebuilding. This is likely to have a major impact on all our communities as the recent National Planning Policy Framework favours the developer over the local community.
